AN ORDINANCE NO. 362.

To smend Sections one (1), five (5) and six (6) of an Ordinance No. 301 passed September 20th, 1921, determining to proceed with the improvement of Fair Avenue from Droxel Avenue to Belgard Lane.

Be it erdsined by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State

of Chie:

Section 1. That Sections one (1), five (5) and Six (6) of an ordinance No. 301 passed September 20th, 1921, determining to proceed with the improvement of Fair Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Belgard Lame be and hereby are smended to read as follows:

Section 1. That it is hereby-dytermined to preced with the improvement of Fair Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Belgard Lame by grading, curbing and paving the readway with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement; constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for said improvement, constructing a water main therein from Cassady Avenue to Belgard Lame, and making water connections from the water main in said avenue with the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvement heretofore approved and new on file in the office of the clock of said village and in pursuance of the resolution declaring it necessary to improve said avenue, adopted by the council of said village on the 2nd. day of June, 1921, A. D. as amended Movember 7, 1922.

Section 5. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in not less than mine or more than ten installments with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be berne by the bends to be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 6. That bends of said village shall be issued in the anticipation of the levy and of the collection of the assessments by installments, and in an amount sufficient to pay that pertian of the estimated cost of said improvement for which special assessments are to be levied and to provide a fund for the payment of not to exceed one years interest on said bends.

Section 2. That original Sections one (1), five (5) and six (6) be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
