Be it erdsined by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of

Onie:

Section 1. That the deed of Jesephine E. Hansberger, Claude R. hansberger, William C. Hansberger and James A. Beery, Executors of the Estate of Charles F. Hansberger, deceased, and Jesephine E. Hansberger, as widew and sele heir at law of Charles F. Hansberger, deceased, executed Nevember Oth., 1922, conveying a certain parcel of ground here-in described to said village for the use of the public as a street, as follows:

A strip of ground twenty feet in width off of the Mast side of Let Number five (5) and a strip of ground thirty (30) feet in width off of the west side of let number six (6) of Bullitt Park Place Addition in said village, be and the same hereby is accepted, and said tract is dedicated for use as a public street forever.
