

AN ORDINANCE NO. 386.

To accept deed of Josephine E. Hansberger, Claude R. Hansberger, William C. Hansberger and James A. Beery, Executors of the Estate of Charles F. Hansberger, deceased, and Josephine E. Hansberger, as widow and sole heir at law of Charles F. Hansberger, deceased, conveying land for street purposes.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the deed of Josephine E. Hansberger, Claude R. Hansberger, William C. Hansberger and James A. Beery, Executors of the Estate of Charles F. Hansberger, deceased, and Josephine E. Hansberger, as widow and sole heir at law of Charles F. Hansberger, deceased, executed November 8th., 1922, conveying a certain parcel of ground here-in described to said village for the use of the public as a street, as follows:

A strip of ground twenty feet in width off of the East side of Lot Number five (5) and a strip of ground thirty (30) feet in width off of the west side of lot number six (6) of Bullitt Park Place Addition in said village, be and the same hereby is accepted, and said tract is dedicated for use as a public street forever.

Section 2. That the clerk hereby is directed to cause said deed to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
