AN ORDINANCE NO. 387.

To smend Section three (3) of an ordinance passed June 13, 1922, entitled "An ordinance No. 347, determining to proceed with the improvement of Cassingham Read from Broad Street to the north line of lots 627 and 704 Ardmere Addition No. 2".

Be it erdained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of

Ohie:

Section 1. That Section three (3) of an ordinance passed June 13.

1922, entitled "An erdinance Ne. 347 determining to preceed with the improvement of Cassingham Read from Broad Street to the north line of lots 627 and 704 be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement less one fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lets and lands, to-wit: All of the lets and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement between the points aforesaid, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited in an amount hereby determined to be specially assessed thereon."

Section 2. That Section three (3) of said original ordinance determine ing to proceed with the improvement of Ardmore Read as aforesaid, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
