

## AN ORDINANCE NO. 389.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Connecticut Avenue from Dawsen Avenue to Cassady Avenue.

Be it erdained by the council of the Village of Bexley. State of

hie:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is levied and assessed the several amounts hereinafter set forth, for the purpose of raising money to pay that part of the cost and expense neretefore determined to be levied and assessed for the improvement of Connectivat Avenue from Dawsen Avenue to Cassady Avenue by grading, curling and paving the roadway with asphalt, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and constructing water and sand tary sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said avenue to the lets and lands fronting and abutting thereon pursuant to and in accordance with Ordinance No. 340 determining to proceed with the said improvement passed by the Council on the 26th. day of April, 1922.

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the essessment nereby levied thereon,

Section z. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the County Auditor of Franklin County, Onio, as previded by law, to be by nim placed upon the tax duplicate for cellection as other taxes are collected and that said assessments shall be payable at the effice of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Onio, in nine equal annual installments, with interest

thereen at the rate of 5% per annum payable semi-annually from and after the first day of April, 1925.

Section 3, That said assessments and all portions thereof shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued in anticipation of the levy and of the cellection of said special assessments, and the interest thereen as the same become due .

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
