## AN ORDINANCE NO. 393.

By Mr. Manly.

Determining to preceed with the improvement of Ardmore Road from Bread Street to the north line of lots 705 and 782 of Ardmore Addition No. 2.

Be it erdained, by the council of the Village of Bexley, State

of Onio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determized to proceed with the improvement of Ardmore Read from Bread Street to the north line of lots 705 and 782 of Ardmore AdditionNo. 2 by grading, curbing and paving the readway with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement; constructing atorm sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, constructing a six inch water line with necessary fire hydrants, and making water connections from the water line in said Read to the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon, ir pursuance of the resolution declaring it necessary to improve said avenue, adopted on the /q day of September, 1922, and in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for said improvement, heretofore approved and now on file in the office of the village clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be medicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement, and that the solicitor be and no hereby is a therized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement less onefiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in propertion
to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described
lets and lands, te-wit:

All lots and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement to the amount hereby determined to be specially assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in not less than nine (9) or more than ten (10) equal annual installments with interest upon the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be berne by the bends to be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 5. That bends of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of assessments by installments and in amount sufficient to may that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement

for which the special assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. Inst the remainder of the cost of said improvement small be paid from the preceds of bends issued by said village in the manner previded by law.

Section 7. That the clerk be and nereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section s. This ordinance shall take effect and be in ferce from and after the earliest perich allowed by law.
