

AN ORDINANCE NO. 394.

By Mr. Phelps.

Determining to proceed with the improvement of Bexley Plaza from Charles Street to the first alley south of Main Street by constructing a six inch water line therein.

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the Village of Bexley,

State of Ohio:

Section 1. That it hereby is determined to proceed with the improvement of Bexley Plaza from Charles Street to the first alley south of Main Street by constructing therein a six (6) inch water line, with necessary fire hydrants and making water connections from said water line to the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon in pursuance of the resolution declaring the necessity for such improvement adopted October 10, 1922, and in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles provided for such improvement, heretofore approved by this Council and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement and that the Solicitor be and hereby is authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands to-wit:

All the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement in an amount equal to that part of the cost hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five equal annual installments with interest on the deferred payments at the same rates as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 5. That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement for which the special assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds issued by said village in the manner

provided by law.

Section 7. That the clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
