## RESOLUTION MO. 324.

Declaring it recessary to construct a certain part of the sewers in sanikary Sewer District No. 4.

WHEREAS, the owners of the lots and lands fronting and abutting upon a public easement or right of way shown and described upon the plat of Semeca. Park Place Addition to the Village of Berley, Ohio, between streets designated on said plat as "Semeca Park Place" and "Elm Avenue" have filed with this council their written petition asking for the construction of a sanitary sewer therein, and

WHEREAS, by the terms of said petition, said swhere consent and agree "That the entire cost of said improvement except only such pertion thereof as is by law chargeable against the Village, may be assessed and collected in equal annual installments in proportion to the whole assessment in the manner which may be fixed by the Council", and

whereas, said ewners also "censent and request that said assessments be levied and cellected without reference to the value of the preperty" of said ewners "and waive all benefits of the provisions of Section 391s of the General Code limiting assessments to thirty-three and one-third per cent of the value of the property assessed for any and all purposes within the period of five years; and also waive all benefits of the provisions of Sections 3814, 3818, 3878 and 3895 of the General Code providing for the service and publication of notice of the proceedings for the construction of said improvement and the making and levying of the assessment therefor."

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Chie:

Section 1. That it is necessary to construct a certain part of the sanitary sewers hereinafter described, provided for in an amended general plan for a system of sanitary sewers in said village designated as sewer district No. 4, adopted by the council on March 15th, 1921, and new on file in the office of the village clerk;

That the perties of the work previded for on the plans of said district which it is nerepy determined to construct will be conducive to the Public Health, Convenience and Welfere, and is as follows:

"An eight (8) inch sanitary sewer in an easement or right of way shown and dedicated for said purpose upon the duly accepted and recorded plat of Seneca Park Place Addition to said Village between Cassady Avenue and Dawson Avenue and midway between streets shown upon said Plat and designated "Seneca Park Place" and "Elm Avenue"."

Section 2. That said sewer shall be constructed of vitrified pipe, with brick mannelss and iren cevers, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles therefore hereby duly approved and on file in the office of the village clerk.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement shall be assessed in propertien to the benfits which may result therefrom upon the fellowing described lots and lands, to-wit:

> "All of the lots and lands, fronting, bounding and abutting upon said easement or right of way between the points aforesaid, except such as may now have adequate sewerage."

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be payable in five (5) substantial equal annual installments with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be berne by the bands issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said assessments.

Section 5. That bends of said village may be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said assessments by installments, and in an amount sufficient to pay the estimated cost of said imprevement.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
