

RESOLUTION NO. 325. ✓

By Mr. Manly.

Declaring it necessary to improve Broad Street between Cassady Avenue and Remington Road by constructing water lines therein.

Be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of

Ohio:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve Broad Street between Cassady Avenue and Remington Road in said village, by constructing an eight (8) inch water line on the north side and a four (4) inch waterline on the south side of Broad Street, with necessary fire hydrants, between the points aforesaid, with accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvements prepared by the engineers of said village and now on file in the office of the village clerk, which plans, specifications, estimates and profiles hereby are approved.

Section 2. That the grade of said street as improved shall be the existing grade, shown by and upon the plans and profiles aforesaid, and the grade of the curbs shall be the grade heretofore established upon which curbs have been constructed.

Section 3. That seventy per centum (70%) of the whole cost of said improvement, including the cost of intersections, shall be paid by said village and the remaining thirty per centum (30%) shall be assessed by the front feet upon the following described lots and lands to-wit: Lots Nos. 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44 and 45 of Ardmore Addition No. 2, all bounding and abutting upon said Broad Street between the points aforesaid, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement and in an amount equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five substantially equal annual installments, with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be hereafter issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 5. That bonds of said village may be issued, in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement hereinbefore determined to be assessed upon the property fronting and abutting thereon.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said improvements shall be paid either from the proceeds of bonds of said village issued in the manner provided by law, or from the street improvement funds of said village.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
