

RESOLUTION NO. 326 ✓

Appointing a board to report an estimated assessment to pay one-half of the cost and expense of appropriating property for opening and extending Ardmore Road.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by council to assess one-half of the cost and expense of appropriating certain real property for the purpose of opening and extending Ardmore Road to Fair Avenue amounting to \$ in proportion to the benefits which may result from said appropriation, upon the property within the district bounded and described as follows:

On the North by the first alley south of Broad Street; on the West by Cassady Avenue; on the South by Fair Avenue, and on East by Rawlinton Road.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that Mr. G. R. Warnemacner, Mr. J. F. Elder and Mr. G. E. Underwood, three disinterested free holders of said village be and they hereby are appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in an Ordinance No. 358 to appropriate said property, passed August 22, 1922, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said appropriation to the several lots and lands so assessed and report to this council said estimated assessment.
