

RESOLUTION NO. 360.

Appointing board to report estimated assessment to pay the cost and expense of improving the first alley east of Parkview Avenue, from Caroline Avenue to the B. & O. tracks, by constructing a water line.

Whereas, it has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost of the improvement of the first alley east of Parkview Avenue, from Caroline Avenue to the B. & O. tracks by constructing a 4 inch water line therein, upon lots numbers 10, 11, 12, and 13 of Bexley Heights Addition to the Village of Bexley, in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement.

NOW THEREFORE:

Be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that C. E. Underwood, J. F. Elder and G. R. Wannemacner, three disinterested free holders of said village be and they hereby are appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in ordinance No. 352 to improve said alley in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots and parcels of land so assessed and to report said estimated assessment to this council.
