

RESOLUTION NO. 382.

To levy taxes for all municipal purposes for the village of Bexley, Ohio, for the year 1923 including an extra levy of two mills authorized by a vote of the electors of said village at the election held November 6, 1923.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5649 - 3a the Council of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, caused to be submitted to the County Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, an annual budget as set forth in said section, stating the amounts of money needed for the ensuing year: and

WHEREAS, by resolution duly adopted by the Council of said village on August 28, 1923, it was declared that the amount of taxes that may be waived by the levy of taxes at the maximum rate authorized by Section 5649-2 General Code within the taxing district of said village will be insufficient for the needs of said village, and that it is expedient and necessary that taxes be levied on all the taxable property in said village for the period of four years at a rate in excess of such maximum rate authorized by said section 5649-2 of the General Code and that it is expedient and necessary to levy taxes for each of the years 1923, 1924, 1925 and 1926 at the rate of two mills for each of said years, on each dollar of the tax value of the taxable property within said village in excess of the rate authorized by said Section 5649-2 of the General Code for the following municipal purposes, to-wit: Health Funds, Public Safety Fund, Public Service Fund and General Fund; and

WHEREAS, by said resolution the question of levying said additional taxes was ordered to be submitted to the Electors of said village at the election to be held on November 6, 1923; and

WHEREAS, notice was given of the adoption of said resolution and of the election to be held on the date aforesaid in the manner provided by law; and

WHEREAS, the question of said additional levy was submitted to said electors at said election and more than two thirds of the electors voting thereon at such election voted in favor thereof, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO, that there be and hereby is levied on all of the taxable property in the taxing district of said Village of Bexley, taxes in accordance with the budget heretofore submitted pursuant to Section 5649-3a of the General Code of Ohio, in accordance with the limitations when said budget was submitted, and in addition

thereto, there be and hereby is levied, two mills on each dollar of the tax value of all the taxable property within said village pursuant to and in accordance with Section 5649-5b of the General Code of Ohio; and that the County Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, be and hereby is directed to apply said extra levy to the years 1923, 1924, 1925 and 1926.

Resolved further, that the village clerk be and hereby is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the auditor and the Budget Commissions of Franklin County, Ohio.

Resolved further that for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, this resolution is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
