

RESOLUTION NO. 384. ✓

Granting permission to F. C. McVey to construct driveway and cut curb on his property on the south side of Main Street between Alum Creek Bridge and 2141 East Main Street.

WHEREAS, F. C. McVey has asked the council of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, for permission to construct a driveway entrance from the roadway on the south side of Main Street over and across the sidewalk or sidewalk space to his property between Alum Creek Bridge and 2141 East Main Street, Now Therefore:

Be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that said F. C. McVey hereby is granted permission to construct said driveway entrance to said property, provided that the same be constructed in such a manner as not to obstruct or interfere with the full use of said sidewalk space by pedestrians; that the same be constructed under the supervision of the village engineers and that the entire cost of construction including the services of the engineers be borne by said F. C. McVey; and provided further that whenever said F. C. McVey, his heirs or assigns, shall abandon or cease to operate said property or driveway for the purpose for which it was intended, he or his heirs or assigns shall remove said driveway across said sidewalk space and relay new sidewalk and replace the curb under the supervision of and to the satisfaction of the village engineers.

Resolved further that this resolution shall be in force and after the earliest period allowed by law, and the written acceptance of the terms and conditions thereof by said F. C. McVey.
