Determining to preceed with the improvement of Remington Read from Broad Street to the north line of lots 532 and 626 of Ardmore Addition No. 2.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State

of Onio:

Section 1. That it is nereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Remington Road from Bread Street to the north line of lots 532 and 626 of Arcmere Addition No. 2 by grading, curbing and paving the readway with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement; constructing sterm sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, constructing a six inch water line in said Road with necessary fire hydrants, and making water connections from the water line in said road to the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon, improvementation and abutting thereon, improvementation repetitioned charling it necessary to improve said avenue, adopted on the 14th day of December, 1922, and in accordance with plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for said improvement, heretofore approved and now on file in the effice of the village clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement, and that the soliciter be and he hereby is authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement less onefiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following
described lets and lands, to-wit:

All lots and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement to the amount hereby determined to be specially assessed & thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in not less than nine (9) or more than ten (10) equal annual installments with interest upon the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 5. That bends of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of assessments by installments and in
an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said imprevement for which the special assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said imprevement shall be paid from the preceeds of bends issued by said village in the manner previded by law.

Section 7. That the clark be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section o. This ordinance small take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
