

AN ORDINANCE NO. 487.

By Mr. O. C. Manly.

To levy special assessments for the construction of a 6" water main in Mound Street from Pleasant Ridge Avenue to Euclaire Avenue.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts hereinafter set forth, for the purpose of raising money to pay that part of the cost heretofore determined to be levied and assessed for The Construction of a 6" water main in Mound Street from Pleasant Ridge Avenue to Euclaire Avenue pursuant to and in accordance with Ordinance No. 376, determining to proceed with the said improvement passed by this council on the 10th. day of October, 1922.

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon.

Section 2. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the clerk of this Council to the County Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected and that said assessments shall be payable at the office of the treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, in five equal annual installments, with interest thereon at the rate of 5% per annum payable semi-annually from and after the first day of October, 1922.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said special assessments and the interest thereon as the same become due.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
