

ORDINANCE NO. 406.

To change the name of Peck Avenue.

WHEREAS, on the 23rd. day of January, 1923, a petition, by persons owning lots in the vicinity of Peck Avenue, was duly presented to the council praying that the name of Peck Avenue be changed to Vernon Road; and,

WHEREAS, council upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such change, as prayed for, that it will not be detrimental to the general interest, and ought to be made, Now Therefore,

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the name of Peck Avenue be and the same hereby is changed to Vernon Road.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
