AN ORDINANCE NO. 410.

By Mr. Dunlap.

Determining to proceed with the improvement of Bexley Drive from Main Street to the North line of the Columbus, Newark, and Zanosville Electric Ry. Co. Property.

Be it erdained, by the emmeil of the village of Bexley, state of this:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Berley Drive, from Main Street to the morth line of the Columbus, Mewark and Zamesville Electric Railway Co. property by grading, curbing and paving the readway with prick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement; constructing sterm sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, constructing a six inch water line with necessary fire hydrants in said Berley Drive between the points aforesaid, and making water connections therefrom to the lets and lands fronting and abutting thereon in pursuance of resolution No. 308 declaring it genessary to improve said steme, adopted on the 19th day of October, 1922, and in accordance with plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for said improvement, heretofore approved and now on file in the office of the village clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvemently and that the selicitor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 5. That the whole cost of said improvement less one fiftieth thereof shall be assessed by the front feet upon the following described leta and lands, to-wit:

All lets and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lets and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement to the amount hereby determined to be specially assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in not less than nine (9) or more than ten (10) equal annual installments with interest upon the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be being by the bends to be hereafter issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 5. That bends of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the levy of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said imprevement for which the special assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds issued by said village in the manner previded by law.

Section 7. That the clerk be and hereby is sutherised and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according te law.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law-
