AN ORDINANCE NO. 412-

Determining2to proceed with the improvement of Reshe Avenue from Main Street to Aster Avenue.

Be it ordained, by the council of the village of Berley, state of Chies

Section 1. That it is horeby determined to proceed with the improvement of Roche Avenue from Main Street to Aster Avenue, by grading, curbing and paving the readmey with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, consrete or some other form of permanent improvement; constructing sterm sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, constructing a six inch water line with necessary fire hydrants in residual temperatures the points aforesaid, and making water connections therefrom to the lets and lands fronting and abutting thereon in pursuance of resolution No. 329 declaring it necessary to improve said avenue, adopted on the 2/ day of family, 1923, and in accordance with plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for said improvement, heretefore approved and new on file in the office of the village clock.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed improvement, and that the selicitor be and he hereby is authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Section 5. That enc-half the cost of that part of said improvement between Main Street and Meand Street along property on the west side thereof ewaed by the Beard of Education of said village plus two per cent (25) of the remaining cost and the cost of intersections shall be paid by said village and the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be assessed in properties to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit:

All lets and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon the east side of the proposed improvement, between Main Street and Agy Ave. and all lets and lands bounding fronting and Lenting upon the west side of waid improvement between Meand Street and Aster Avenue which said lets and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement to the amount hereby determined to be specially assessed thereone

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in not less than nine (9) or more than ten (10) equal assess installments with interest upon the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be berne by the bends to be hereafter issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 5. That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of assessments by installments and in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement for which the special assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid the provocas of bonds issued by said village in the manner provided by the

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the carliest period allowed by law.
