

AN ORDINANCE NO. 416.

Determining to proceed with the improvement of
Broad Street between Cassady and Remington Road
by constructing water lines therein.

Be it ordained, by the council of the village of Bexley, State
of Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the
improvement of Broad Street between Cassady Avenue and Remington Road in
said village, by constructing an eight (8) inch water line on the north
side and a four (4) inch water line on the south side of Broad Street
between said points, together with necessary fire hydrants in pursuance
of the resolution declaring it necessary to so improve said street, adopted
on the 9th day of January 1923, and in accordance with plans, speci-
fications, estimates and profiles for said improvement, heretofore approved
and now on file in the office of the village clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting therefrom
shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the proposed
improvement, and that the solicitor be and he hereby is authorized and
directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction
to inquire into such claims.

Section 3. That seventy per centum (70%) of the whole cost
of said improvement including the cost of intersections, shall be paid by
said village and the remaining thirty per centum (30%) shall be assessed
by the front feet upon the following described lots and lands to-wit: Lots
Nos. 2, 7, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 18, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, and
45 of Ardmore addition No. 2, all bounding and abutting upon said Broad
Street between the points aforesaid, which said lots and lands hereby are
determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement and in an amount
equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed
thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid
in five substantially equal annual installments, with interest on the deferred
payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be hereafter issued
in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

CUTTING

Section 5. That bonds of said village may be issued, in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement hereinbefore determined to be assessed upon the property fronting and abutting thereon.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds issued by said village in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. That the clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
