## AN ORDINANCE NO. 417.

To provide for the issue of bonds in amticipation of the lovy and of the collection of special assessments for the construction of branch drains or sewers to connect with a main drain or sewer for the purpose of furnishing surface and atom water drainage for that part of the territory within the Village of Bexley deceinafter described.

WHEREAS, the Village Clerk parsment to the provisions of sections 2295-7 of the General Code of Chie, has certified to this Council that the estimated life of the improvement proposed to be constructed from the proceeds of the bonds hereinafter mentioned, is 25 years, and has further certified the maximum maturity of such bonds calculated in accordance with the previsions of sections 2295-9 of the General Code, to be 25 years, and

WHEREAS, this Council estimates that the special assessments for the payment of said bends and a tax to provide for any deficiency at the levy or collection of said assessments will first appear upon the duplicate for the tax year 1923, and that the final tax settlement with the County Treasurer next following the inclusion of such tax in the annual budget by the County Audit or as provided by law, will be obtained not earlier than the first day of September, 1924, and will require \$1,292.50 for interest until such assessment and taxes are collected and available.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That bends of said Village shall be issued in the aggregate amount of \$23,500.00 for the purpose of raising mensy in amticipation of the lovy and of the collection of special assessments to pay that portion of the cost and expense heretofore determined to be assessed for the construction of branch drains or sowers to connect with a main drain or sewer for the purpose of furnishing surface and storm water drainage to that part of the territory in said Village bounded as follows, to-wit:

Street and in the center line produced southerly of the alley between Reche Avenue and Pock Avenue; themse mertherly with the conger line of said alley and with said center line produced to a point in the north line of Main Street; themse easterly with the north line of Main Street to a point where the same intersects the east corporation line; themse southerly with the cast corporation line to a point 160 ft. south of the south line of Charles Street; themse

we terly and parallel to the south line of Charles Street and 160 ft.

distant therefrom to the place of beginning. In pursuance of Ordinance No.

402 determining to preced with said improvement passed January 25rd, 1925,

and to provide a fund for the payment of not to exceed one year's interest on
said bends.

Severfimprovement bends," and serially summbered from one (1) to twenty-five (25) beth inclusive. Tempty of said bends shall be of the demandation of \$1,000.00 each, five of said bends shall be of the demandation of \$700.00 each, bearing date of April 1st, 1925, and shall bear interest at therate of five and one-heaf (55%) per sent per summ, payable semi-summally on the first day of April and October each year, for which interest coupons bearing the few simile signature of the Clerk of said Village shall be attached to and made part thereof. Said bends shall fall due and be payable in the order of their serial number as follows, to-with Four bends of one thousand dellars (\$1,000.00) each and one seven numbered dellar (\$700.00) bend on the first day of October in each of the years 1924, both inclusive.

Seliciter, signed by the Mayer and Village Clerk, and scaled with the scale of the village of Bexley; they shall express upon their face the passess at fer which they are issued, and the fact that they are issued pursuant to law, and this ordinance; they shall be payable, both principal and interest, at the effice of the Treasurer of the Village; and shall be issued and sold under the direction of the finance committee of this council.

and account interest realized therefrom shall be paid to the sinking fund trustees to be applied to the payment of the principal and interest of said bends. The par value realized from the sale of said bends shall be deposited in the village treasury to the credit of the "Branch Storm Sewer improvement fund" and shall be disbursed from said fund on proper vouchers in payment of that part of the cost of the improvement aforested, heretofore determined to be especiably assessed, for which purpose said mency is hereby appropriated.

Section 5. That all installments of said aspessments and all pertions thereof, tegether with interest thereon shall be applied to the payment of said bends and interest as the same become due, and to me other purpose whatever.

Seation 6. That said bends shall be full general obligations of said village, and for the payment of the principal and interest of the same, the full faith, credit and revenues of said village shall be and hereby are pledged.

Section 7. That for the purpose of previding the necessary furnis to pay the interest and the principal of said bends promptly when and as they mature, and to create and maintain a sinking fund sufficient to dischafge said bends at maturity, there enable be and hereby is levied on all the taxable property of said village in addition to all other taxes, a direct tax annually until the maximum date of maturity of said bends in an amount sufficient to provide for any deficiency in the levyk payment or collection of said assessments as they fail due. That said taxes shall be and hereby are ordered computed, certified, levied and extended upon the tax duplicate and collected by the same officer, in the same manner and at the same time that taxes for general purposes for each year are certified, extended and collected. That all funds derived from the tax levies hereby made, shall be placed in a separate and distinct fund, which together with all interest collected on the same, and is irrevocably pledged for the payment of the interest and principal of said bends when and as the same fall due.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and po in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
