ORDINANCE NO. 429.

By Mr. Frye.

To Create the Office of and to Provide for the Appointment of a Building Inspector.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY STATE OF

OHIO:

Section 1. That the office of Building Inspector in and for said village hereby is created and the Mayor hereby is authorized and empowered to proint an inspector of buildings in and for said village subject to confirmation by no Council, at a salary of not to exceed \$1800.00 per annum, payable in equal monthly installments. Such inspector shall have all the powers and shall perform all of the duties granted and imposed by the laws of this and the ordinances of the willings. His term of office shall be so-extensive with that of the Mayor.

Section 2. That it shall be unlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation to construct, erect, repair, alter or add to any building or other structure in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, except in compliance with the terms and previsions contained in this and all other ordinances of the village.

Section 3. Building Permit Foos - That it shall be umlawful for any person, persons, firm or corporation to construct, erect, repair, alter or aid to smy building or structure in the Village of Bexley, Ohie, until he or they shall have made application to and received from the inspector of buildings of said village a permit se te de. Such applicant shall furnish said inspecter with a written statement on blanks to be furnished by the inspector, of the location, intended use and estimated cost of the prepesed buildings or structures, a prepesed repair, alteration or addition thereto, together with complete deplicate set of plants and specifications of the same plans to be in ink or blueprint, one set of said plans and specifications shall remain in the custedy of the inspector, the other set of plans and specifications to be so marked and returned to the applicant with permit. If it shall appear to the inspector that the laws and ordinances in force upon the subject have been complied with ne shall give the permit asked for, upon payment of fees as fellows: "The sum of Four cents for each and every mindred cubic & et of centents of said building or structure. And for additions, a teration and repairs to buildings and structures the cost of which is \$1000 or over the sum of \$2.00 per \$1000 of cost or fractional part thereof to be charged in addition to the sum of \$1.00 for the permit. For additions, alterations or megains to buildings and structures, the cost of which is less than \$1000, the sum of \$1200cmly will be charged for the permit.

Section 4. Reveatier of Permit. Each and every permit issued by the inspector of buildings small be subject to revocation by said impoctor who never it appears that summa building or structure is being so constructed that the same, or any part thereof, encreasnes upon any street, alley er other public place, er it being so constructed as to violate any of the terms or condition s of this erdinance or any other ordinance of the village of Bexley er any statte of the State of Chie, relating to the location, erection, alteration or repair of buildings.
