

An Ordinance No. 432.

By Mr. R. J. Wharton.

To establish a safety zone on Drexel Avenue north of Main Street and regulate the parking of vehicles thereon.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That a safety zone hereby is established in Drexel Avenue between Main Street and a point 56 feet north therefrom.

Section 2. That no vehicle shall stand or be parked on Drexel Avenue between Main Street and a point 56 feet north therefrom from six A. M. until nine P. M.

Section 3. Any person found guilty of violating the provisions of Section two (2) of this ordinance shall be fined not not less than one (\$1.00) dollar nor more than twenty-five (\$25) dollars.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
