## AN ORDINANCE NO. 434.

By Mr. Frye.

Determining to preceed with construction and installation of a system of lighting for certain streets and avenues in the Village of Berley, Chie.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Berley, State of Chie:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with constructien and installation of a system for lighting Main Street from the west to the east corporation line; Broad Street from the west to the east corporation line; College Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue; Euclaire Avenue from Main Street to Livingsten Avenue: Parkview Avenue from Main Street to Caroling Avenue: Town Street from Parkview Avenue to Drexel Avenue; Columnia Avenue from Town Street to Maryland Avenue; Stanbery Avenue from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue; Ashbourne Road; Ashbonene Place; Drexel Avenue from Main Street to Maryland Avenue; Sherwood Read from Drexel Avenue to Belgard Lane; Bryden Road from Drexel Avenue te Belgard Lame; Bexley Park Road 2rem Drexel Avenue to Belgard Lame; Brentwood Road from Draxel Avenue to Belgard Lane; Pleasant Ridge Avenue from its southern terminus to Main Street; and Bullitt Park Place from Broad Street to Bexley Avenue. by laying under ground cables, erecting iron or steel light standards, installing lamps, circuits and other necessary equipment, in pursuance of a resolution No. 361 declaring it necessary to previde for lighting certain screets in said village adopted em June 28, 1923, and in accordance with plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for waid system of lighting heretsfore approved and on file in the effice of the village clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting from the construction and installation of said lighting system shall be judicially inquired into after the completion thereof, and the solicitor be and hereby is authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of Competent Jurisaliction to inquire into such claims.

Sestion 5. That the whole cost of constructing and installing said system for lighting said streets and avenues except one-fiftieth thereof and the cost of intersections shall be levied and assessed by the foot front of the property bounding and abutting upon said streets and avenues respectively, which said property, lets and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by the construction and installation of said lighting system in an amount equal to the cost thereof.

Section 4. That the special assessments so to be levied

shall be not less than nine or more than ten substantially equal annual installments with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be berne
by the bonds to be nereafter issued in anticipation of the collection of such
assessments.

Section 5. That money shall be berrowed and the notes of said village issued therefor in an amount not to exceed the estimated cost of said improvement, due and payable not later than two years from the date of issue, in anticipation of the levy of said special assessments, and of the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection of said special assessments.

Section o. That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of said special assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement for which said assessments are levied.

Section 7. That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds of said village issued in the manner provided by lax.

Section s. That the Clerk of said village be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction and installation of said system of lighting in the manner provided by law.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
