

AN ORDINANCE NO. 437.

To accept deed of Angie E. Fishpaw conveying land for street purposes.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the deed of Angie E. Fishpaw conveying a certain parcel of ground here-in described to said village for the use of the public as a street, as follows:

Beginning at a stake in the south line of the aforesaid tract, which stake is located 375.74 ft. westerly from a stake in the west line of College Avenue at the south-east corner of said tract; thence from said beginning point N. 12° 15' W. 47.85 ft. to a stake in the north line of said tract, which stake is located 376.80 ft. westerly from a stake in the west line of College Avenue at the north-east corner of said tract; thence westerly with the said north line 51.83 ft. to a stake; thence S. 12° 15' E. parallel to and 50 ft. distant from the line first described 47.85 ft. to a stake in the south line of said tract; thence easterly with the said south line 51.83 ft. to the place of beginning, containing 0.055 acres, be and the same hereby is accepted, and said tract is dedicated for use as a public street forever.

Section 2. That the clerk hereby is directed to cause said deed to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
