And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefitted by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon.

Section 2. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the Clerk of his Council to the County Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected and that said assessments shall be payable at the effice of the treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, in Fuve equal annual installments, with

interest therees at the rate of 5% per ansum payable semi-annually from and after the first day of April, 1924.

Section 3. That said assessments and all pertiens thereof shall be applied to the payment of the bends issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said special assessments and the interest thereen as the same become due.
