

AN ORDINANCE NO. 438.

To levy special assessments for the construction of a Sanitary Sewer in an Easement between Elm Avenue and Seneca Park Place from Dawson Avenue to Cassidy Avenue.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing a Sanitary Sewer in an Easement between Elm Avenue to Cassidy Avenue aggregating in amount to the sum of \$1196.16 reported to this council on the 24th day of July, 1923, by an estimating Board heretofore appointed to report to this council an estimated assessment of the cost and expense upon the lots and lands to be charged therewith notice of the filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that there be and hereby be levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts hereinafter set forth, for the purpose of raising money to pay that part of the cost and expense heretofore determined to be levied and assessed for the construction of said sanitary sewers pursuant to and in accordance with Ordinance No. 403, Determining to proceed with the said improvement passed by this Council on the 23rd. day of January, 1923.

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefitted by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon.

Section 2. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected and that said assessments shall be payable at the office of the treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, in Five equal annual installments, with

interest thereon at the rate of 5% per annum payable semi-annually from and after the first day of April, 1924.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said special assessments and the interest thereon as the same become due.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
