That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor of Franklin County Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected and that said assessments shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Chio, in 9 equal annual installments, with interest thereon at the rate of 55 per centum per annum, payable seei-

annually from and after the first day of agrid, 1924.

Section 3. That said aggessments and all portions thereof shall be applied to the payment of the bends issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said special assessments and the interest thereon as the same become due.
