

AN ORDINANCE NO. 447.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Bexley Drive.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the estimated assessment of the cost of improving Bexley Drive from Main Street to the North line of the Columbus, Newark and Zanesville Electric Railway Company's property aggregating in amount \$11,239.03 reported to this Council on the 14th day of August, 1923, by an estimating board heretofore appointed to report to this council an estimated assessment of such cost upon the lots and lands to be charged therewith, notice of the filing of which assessment having been given as required by law, be and the same hereby is adopted and confirmed, and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described the several amounts hereinafter set forth for the purpose of raising money to pay that part of cost heretofore determined to be specially levied and assessed for the construction of said improvement pursuant to and in accordance with ordinance No. 410, determining to proceed with said improvement passed by this council on the 13th day of March, 1923.

And it is hereby determined and declared by this Council that said lots and lands are each benefitted by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon.

Section 2. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the Clerk of this Council to the County Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection

as other taxes are collected and that said assessments shall be payable at the office of the treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, in nine (9) equal annual installments, with interest thereon at the rate of 5½ per centum per annum, payable semi-annually, from and after the first day of October, 1924.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said special assessments and the interest thereon as the same become due.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
