

AN ORDINANCE NO. 454.

To change the name of Rudolpn Avenue and Bexley Plaza to Cassingham Road.

WHEREAS, on October 9, 1923, the owner of lots in the immediate vicinity of Rudolpn Avenue between Fair Avenue and Main Street and in the vicinity of Bexley Plaza Avenue, between Main Street and Charles Street in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, have filed a petition with the Council praying that the names of said avenues between the points aforesaid be changed to Cassingham Road, and

WHEREAS, the Council of said village upon hearing is satisfied that there is good cause for such change of name and that the same will not be detrimental to the general interest, NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF

Ohio:

Section 1. That the name of Rudolpn Avenue, between Fair Avenue and Main Street, and the name of Bexley Plaza Avenue between Main Street and Charles Street be changed to the name of "Cassingham Road".

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
