

AN ORDINANCE NO. 400.

By Mr. Dunlop.

Declaring it necessary and determining to proceed with the erection of a public building in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, for the use of the Council and Village officials and other public purposes.

WHEREAS said village has no public building for the use of its Council and other public officials, and,

WHEREAS said village owns a tract of ground on Main Street and within its corporate limits, wherein such building can be erected, Now Therefore,
Be it Ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That it is necessary and it is hereby determined to proceed with the erection of a public building in said village, for the purpose of providing a meeting place for the village council, and offices for other village officials, and for other public purposes, in accordance with plans, specifications and estimates, on file with the village clerk and hereby approved.

Section 2. That the sum of \$2500.00 hereby is appropriated from the General fund to pay the cost of constructing said building.

Section 3. That the clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said building according to law.

Section 4. As it is necessary for the preservation of the public safety of the inhabitants of the village that said building be constructed without delay, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
