Declaring it necessary to construct a sanitary sewer in part of sanitary sewer District No. 4.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF GAIO:

That it is necessary to construct a certain part hereinafter described for of the samitary sewers provided in a general plan for a system of sewerage for said village, which general plan was adopted by Council on the lith day of June, 1918, and is now on file in the office of the Clerk of said village; and that the portions of the work provided for in said general plan, which it is hereby determined to construct, are as follows, to-wit: The samitary sewer shown upon the plan of said sewer District No. 4, at the intersection of Astor Avenue and the alley between Montrose Avenue and Roche Avenue, thence north in said alley between to Mound Street. The boundaries of that part of said District No. 4 so to be improved, are embraced in Lots Numbers Two Hundred Eighty-one (281) to Three Hundred Two (302) inclusive and Three hundred Twenty-one(321) to Three Hundred Two (342) inclusive of Rider's Addition in said village.

Be it further resolved that said sewers, to gether with the necessary nouse connections for each lot fronting and abutting upon said improvement shall be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the clerk of said village and shall be of vitrified pipe.

me it further resolved that in accordance with the petition for said improvement filed by the abutting property owners, the entire cost inclusive of alley and street intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits whichmay result from said improvement upon all the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, being the lots hereinabove designated, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement; and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of preliminary and other surveys, and the printing and publishing of notices, resolutions and ordinances required, the serving of such motices, the cost of construction, together with interest on londs issued in articipation of the collection of deferred assessments and all other necessary expenditures.

Be it further resolved that the Clerk be, and is nereby, authorized to cause this resolution to be published in the manner provided by law.
