

RESOLUTION NO. 415.

To appropriate money for payment of village's portion of cost of appropriating property for the opening and extending of Bexley Drive.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance No. 440, passed August 26th, 1923, it was determined that one-half of the cost of appropriating property for the opening and extending of Bexley Drive in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, should be paid from the proceeds of bonds issued in the manner provided by law, or from the general funds of said village not appropriated for any other purpose, and,

WHEREAS, said Village's portion of said appropriation amounts to Eight hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$865.00), which it is hereby determined shall be paid from the general funds of the Village not appropriated for any other purpose, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That there be, and hereby is, appropriated out of the general funds of the Village of Bexley, the sum of Eight hundred Sixty-five Dollars (\$865.00) for the purpose of paying the Village's portion of the cost of appropriating property for the opening and extending of Bexley Drive and said funds shall be used for no other purpose.
