

RESOLUTION NO. 433.

Appointing board to report estimated assessments to pay the cost and expenses of improving certain streets in the Village of Bexley.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost, less one-fiftieth (1/50th) thereof and the cost of intersections, of the improvement of the following described streets in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvements, to-wit: Ardmore Road from Broad Street to Fair Avenue; Cassingham Road from Broad Street to Fair Avenue; Elm Avenue from Dawson to Cassady Avenue; Roosevelt Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue; and Bexley Drive from the north property line of the Columbus, Newark and Zanesville Railway Company to Livingston Avenue, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That C. E. Underwood, C. E. Lynas and Herman J. Engler, three disinterested free holders of said village, be, and they are hereby, appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in the respective ordinances to improve said streets as follows: Ordinance No. 463, to improve said Ardmore Road, passed January 8th, 1924; Ordinance No. 461, to improve said Cassingham Road, passed January 8th, 1924; Ordinance No. 465, to improve said Elm Avenue, passed January 15th, 1924; Ordinance No. 462, to improve said Roosevelt Avenue, passed January 8th, 1924; Ordinance No. 494, to improve said Bexley Drive, passed April 15th, 1924; said assessments to be in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said improvements to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council the said estimated assessment.
