

RESOLUTION NO. 437. ✓

Appointing board to report estimated assessments to pay the cost and expense of constructing a water line in Broad Street and a sanitary sewer in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 4.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost, less one-fiftieth (1/50th) thereof, of the construction of an eight (8) inch water line with necessary fire hydrants and making water connections therefrom to the lots and lands fronting and abutting therein, in Broad Street between Parkview Avenue and a point Four Hundred (400) feet west of the west line of Cheek Bros. Addition, in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, and to assess the whole cost inclusive of alley and street intersections of the construction of a sanitary sewer in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 4, as described in Resolution No. 503, adopted by the council of said village on May 13, 1924, in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

That C. E. Underwood, C. E. Lynas and Herman J. Engler, three disinterested free holders of said village, be, and they are hereby, appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in the respective ordinances to construct said improvements as follows: Ordinance No. 5, To construct a water line in said Broad Street, passed September 9, 1924, and Ordinance No. 503, to construct said sanitary sewer, passed May 13, 1924; said assessments to be in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said improvements to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council the said estimated assessment.
