Section 2. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the clerk of this Council to the County Auditor of Franklin County,

Ohie, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected and that said assessments shall be payable at the effice of the treasurer of Franklin County, Ohie, in two equal annual installments, with interest thereon at the rate of $5\frac{1}{2}$ per centum per annum payable semi-annually from and after the first day of April, 1924.

Section 3. That said assessments and all pertiens thereof shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said special assessments and the interest thereon as the same become due.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
