

ORDINANCE NO. 496.

By Mr. Phelps.

To fix the location and width and to establish the grade of sidewalks on Fair Avenue between Drexel Avenue and Cassady Avenue.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That when sidewalks are constructed on Fair Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, between Drexel Avenue and Cassady Avenue, said sidewalks shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor, heretofore adopted by council, and now on file in the office of the village clerk.

Section 2. Said sidewalks when constructed shall be $4\frac{1}{2}$ feet in width, with a cross slope of $\frac{3}{4}$ inch per foot and shall be placed with the inside edge, being the edge next to the lot line, one foot from the property line and said inside edge of said sidewalk shall be 4 inches above the curb and shall run parallel with said curb. The foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the property line.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
