

ORDINANCE NO. 496.

Giving permission to J. P. Mason to tap sewer in alley south of main Street between Vernon Road and Roosevelt Avenue.

WHEREAS, J. P. Mason, owner of Lot Number One (1) East Lawa Addition to the Village of Bexley, Ohio, located at the corner of main Street and Roosevelt Avenue has petitioned for permission to tap the sewer now constructed in the alley south of main Street between Vernon Road and Roosevelt Avenue for the drainage of Lot Number One (1) of East Lawa Addition, and has signed in writing, a waiver on behalf of himself, his heirs and assigns, agreeing with the Village that when that part of the system of sewerage already designated for said Village shall be constructed in the alley east of Onelisea Avenue or the alley south of said premises, said lot may be assessed for its proper portion of the cost of either sewer, and waiving the right to claim exemption from such assessment on the ground that said premises already has, or may have, adequate sewerage, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said J. P. Mason, in consideration of said waiver and agreement, is hereby granted permission to tap into said sewer, now in the alley south of main Street between Vernon Road and Roosevelt Avenue for the sewerage of Lot Number One (1) of East Lawa Addition, and to lay, at his own expense, the necessary sewer in the alley south of said premises to connect said lot with said tap.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
