

AN ORDINANCE NO. 500.

To amend Section 11, paragraph (n) of the Traffic Code of the Village of Bexley, being Ordinance No. 450.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 11, paragraph (n) of the Traffic Code of the Village of Bexley, being Ordinance No. 450, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

(n) Whoever having charge of any vehicle shall run into or against any curbing or sidewalk, or any danger signal or warning sign or standard thereof, or any light standard, along any street or public way, thereby cracking, breaking, or otherwise injuring the same, or shall crack, break, or otherwise injure or deface the same by unloading or throwing upon the same in a hasty manner, rough or careless manner, any stone, iron, building material, or other heavy body or substance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than five nor more than One Hundred dollars.

Section 2. Paragraph (n) of Section 11 of said Ordinance No. 450 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
