

ORDINANCE NO. 501.

WHEREAS, Francesca Rudolpn has executed her deed to the Village of Bexley for certain premises for alley purposes, bearing date of April 25th, 1924, for the following described premises: Situate in the County of Franklin, State of Ohio, and in the Village of Bexley, to-wit:

Being a part of Lot Number Six (6) of Joseph Rudolpn Heirs Partition in Marion Township, as shown upon the recorded plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book No. 7, page 160, Recorder's Office, Franklin County, Ohio, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the north line of said Lot Number Six (6), said point being the N. E. Corner of Lot Number Sixty-five (65) Rudolpn's Fairwood Addition; thence southerly with the east line of said Rudolpn's Fairwood Addition, 295.33 feet to a point; thence easterly on a line parallel with the south line of said lot, 20 feet to a point; thence northerly and parallel with the east line of Rudolpn's Fairwood Addition and 20 feet therefrom to a point in the north line of said lot; thence westerly with the north line of said Lot Number Six (6), 20 feet to the place of beginning,

said deed expressing a consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and the benefits that will accrue to grantor, and

WHEREAS, it will be for the best interest for the Village to accept said conveyance, now, THEREFORE,


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:


Section 1. That the deed of Francesca Rudolpn, bearing date of April 25th, 1924, conveying to the Village of Bexley, Ohio, the above described tract of land for alley purposes, be, and the same is hereby, accepted and the clerk is hereby directed to certify upon said deed acceptance thereof by Council and to file same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 2. This ordinance is to take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
