ORDINANCE NO. 501.

Whereas, Francesca Rudolph has executed her deed to the Village of Bexley for certain premises for alley purposes, bearing date of April 25th, 1924, for the following described premises: Situate in the County of Franklin, State of Onio, and in the Village of Bexley, to-wit:

Being a part of Lot Number Six (6) of Joseph Rudolph Heirs Partition in Maries Township, as shown upon the recorded plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book No. 7, page 166, Recorder's Office, Franklix County, Onio, and more particularly described as follows:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VALLAGE OF SEXLEY, STATE OF CHIO:
Section 1. That the deed of Francesca Rudolph, bearing date of April
25th, 1924, conveying to the Village of Bexley, Onio, the above described tract
of land for alley purposes, be, and the same is mereby, accepted and the clerk is
nereby directed to certify upon said deed acceptance thereof by Council and to
file same for record in the Recorder's Office of Franklin County, Onio.

Section 2. This ordinance is to take effect and me in force from and after the earliest period allewed by law.
