## Am URDINANCE NO. 505.

Authorizing the perrowing of money and issuing of the motes of the Village of Bexley, Onic, in anticipation of the levy of special assessments for the construction of a samitary sewer in part of Samitary Sewer District No. 4, and poing the samitary sewer shown by the plan of said Sewer District No. 4, commoncing at the intersection of Aster Avenue and the alley between mentrese Avenue and Roche Avenue, running thence north in said alley to mound Street.

Section 1. That the Village of Bexley, Onio, be, and hereby is authorized to berrow money in the sum of \$3000.00 and to issue the notes of said village therefor, in anticipation of the lovy of special assessments and issue of bonds in anticipation of the collection of said assessments, as provided by Section 3-14 of the General Code, to pay the costs heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the construction of the sanitary sewer shown upon the plan of Sower District No. 4, commencing at the intersection of Astor Avenue and the alley between Montrose Avenue and Rosee Avenue, runking thence herth in said alley to mound Street, as provided by Resolution No. 407 declaring the necessity therefor, adopted April oth, 1924, and in pursuance of Ordinance No. 503, determining to proceed with said improvement, passed May 13th, 1924.

each, or such smaller denomination as shall be necessary, shall be signed by the mayor, attested by the Clerk, be sealed with the seal of the Village, bear date as issued, and shall be due and payable not later than two years from date of issue. Said notes shall be numbered from one (1) to three (3), inclusive, and shall bear interest at the lowest rate obtainable, but not in excess of 6% per annum, payable semi-annually. The proceeds of bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments and all of the assessments collected for said improvement shall be applied to the payment of said notes thereon until both are fully paid; thereafter said assessments shall be applied to the payment of said bonds and interest thereon.

Section 3. That the Finance Committee of Council shall cause said notes to be properly prepared, executed and sold according to law, to the person, persons, company or corporation efforing the lawest rate of interest, and shall deposit the proceeds in the Village Treasury to the credit of Sanitary Sewer commencing at the intersection of Aster Avenue and the alley between mentrose Avenue and Roche Avenue fund.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and

after the earliest period allowed by law. Adepted may 27, 1924.
