

## AN ORDINANCE NO. 518.

By Mr. Wheaton.

To levy special assessments for the cost and expense of appropriating property for the opening and extending of Bexley Drive so as to constitute a continuous thoroughfare from Main Street to Livingston Ave.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of appropriating property for the opening and extending of Bexley Drive so as to constitute a continuous thoroughfare from Main Street to Livingston Avenue, heretofore determined to be specially assessed, amounting in the aggregate to \$865.00 as reported to this council on the 8th day of July, 1924, by the Village engineer, notice of filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be, and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described, bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessment, together with the description of said lots and lands, are now on file in the office of the Clerk of this Council, to-wit:

It is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots and lands are specially benefitted by said improvement in an amount equal to said assessment.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of

this ordinance, or at the option of the owner in one annual payment with interest at the rate of 5%, being the same rate of interest chargeable upon the note issued in anticipation of the levy and collection of said assessments. All cash payments shall be made to the treasurer of the Village of Bexley and all assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the County Auditor as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
