

AN ORDINANCE NO. 524.

Giving permission to Abbie McNally to tap sanitary and storm sewers and water main in the intersection of Maryland Avenue and Stanbery Road.

WHEREAS, Abbie McNally, owner of part of Lot Number Thirty-four (34) of the Subdivision of the estate of Anton Ruhl in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, Plat Book No. 8, page 7-A, said part of Lot being off the West side of Lot Number Thirty-four (34) and fronting 110 feet on Maryland Avenue and extending northerly 170 feet, has petitioned for permission to tap the sanitary sewer, the storm sewer and water main now in the intersection of Maryland Avenue and Stanbery Road for the drainage of sanitary sewage and storm water from, and to supply water to the dwelling house which she is constructing upon said premises and has signed in writing a waiver on behalf of herself, her heirs and assigns agreeing with the Village that when that part of the system of sewerage, sanitary and storm, designed for said village, or water main, shall be constructed in Maryland Avenue westwardly from their present termini, the above described premises may be assessed for its proper proportion of the cost of said sewers and water main and waiving the right to claim exemption from such assessments on the ground that said premises already have or may have adequate sewerage and water service, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That said Abbie McNally, in consideration of said waiver and said agreement, is hereby granted permission to tap into said sanitary sewer, storm sewer and water main now located in the intersection of Maryland Avenue and Stanbery Road for the sewerage and water service of the dwelling house being constructed upon the premises owned by her, being part of Lot Number Thirty-four (34) of the Subdivision of the estate of Anton Ruhl as shown upon Plat Book No. 8, page 7-A, said part of Lot being off of the West Side thereof, fronting 110 feet on Maryland Avenue and extending northerly 170 feet as hereinabove described, and to lay at her own expense and under the supervision of the Street Commissioner of the Village of Bexley, the necessary sewer and water line to connect said premises with said sanitary and storm sewers and water main and to connect same therewith with necessary taps.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
