AN ORDINANCE NO. 525.

Determining to proceed with the improvement of Broad Street between Parkview Avenue and a point Four Hundred (400) feet west of the west line of Cheek Berthers Addition, by constructing an eight (8) inch water line with the necessary fire hydrants.

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Broad Street between Parkview Avenue and a point Four Hundred (400) feet west of the west line of Cheek Brothers Addition in the Village of Bexley by constructing an eight (8) inch water line with necessary fire hydrants therein and making water connections therefrom to the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon, in pursuance of a Resolution No. 428, declaring it necessary to make said improvement, adopted July 22nd, 1924, and in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles heretofere approved and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting from said improvement shall be judicially inquired into after the completion of the improvement and the solicitor is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to inquire into such claims.

Segtion 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one fiftieth (1/50) thereof, shall be specially assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: Being all of the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon saidproposed improvement between the points aforesaid, except Lot Number Six (6) of Block Nine (9) of Bullitt Park Extension, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in an amount equal to that part of the cost thereof, hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the special assessments to be levied shall be paid in five equal annual installments with interest on deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be hereafter issued in anticipation of the collection of such assessments.

payable not later than two years from the date of issue, in anticipation of the levy of said special assessments and of the issuance of bonds in anticipation of the collection thereof as provided in Section 3914 of the General Code of Ohio. Said notes shall not exceed in amount that portion of the estimated cost of the improvement for which said

special assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of said improvement hereinbefore determined to be assessed upon the property fronting and abutting thereon.

Section 7. That the village's pertien of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds is sued by said village in the manner provided by law.

Section 8. That the Clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 9. This ordinance shall take effect and be in ferce from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
