## AN ORDINANCE NO. 532.

Giving permission to Herbert Parkinson to tap water main in the first alley south of Main Street.

Addition to the Village of Bexley, Ohio, has petitioned for permission to tap the water main now in the first alley south of Main Street to supply water to the dwelling how re which he is now erecting on the above described premises and has signed a waiver in writing on behalf of himself, his heirs and assigns, agreeing with the Village that when the water main shall be constructed past said premises the above described lot may be assessed for its proper proportion of the cost of said construction and waiving the right to claim exemption from such assessments on the ground that said premises already have or may have adequate water service, NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IN ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF CHIO:

section 1. That said Herbert Parkinson, in consideration of said waiver and said agreement, is hereby granted permission to tap into water main now located in the first alley south of Main Street and connect the premises hereinabove described therewith for the water service of the dwelling house being constructed thereon and to lay at his own expense the necessary water line to connect said premises therewith, said work to be done under the supervision of the Street Commissioner of the Village of Bexley, Chio.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
