

AN ORDINANCE NO. 539.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Stanwood Road from Fair Avenue to Broad Street, by constructing a six (6) inch water line therein with the necessary fire hydrants and water connections.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Stanwood Road from Fair Avenue to Broad Street, by constructing a six (6) inch water line with necessary fire hydrants and water connections, pursuant to and in accordance with an Ordinance No. 484, determining to proceed with said improvement passed by Council on the 18th day of March, 1924, amounting in the aggregate to Seventy-five Hundred Dollars (\$7,500.00) as reported to this Council on the 5th day of September, 1924, by the board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessments, notice of filing of which assessment has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby, adopted and confirmed; and that there be, and is hereby, levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which said assessments, together with the descriptions of said lots and lands are as follows, to-wit:

And it is hereby determined and declared by this council that said lots and lands are each benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment hereby levied thereon and that said assessments are in proportion to the special benefits.

Section 2. That the total assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be paid in cash within thirty days from and after the passage of this ordinance, or at the option of the owner, in five annual installments, with interest at the rate of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ % per annum, from November 20th, 1924. All cash payments shall be made to the treasurer of said village. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk to the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

**NOTICE OF ASSESSMENTS
WATER MAINS.**

Notice is hereby given that the estimated assessments of the cost of constructing the water mains, as listed below, on the lots and lands benefited and to be charged therewith as set forth in resolutions and ordinances to construct said water mains, has been made and reported to council and said estimated assessments are now on file in the office of the clerk of the council of the village of Bexley, Ohio, for the inspection and examination of all persons interested therein.

- (a) Fair Avenue from Belgard Lane to Hartley Road.
- (b) Main Street from Vernon Road to Roosevelt Avenue.
- (c) Powell Avenue from Hartley Road to Gould Road.
- (d) Remington Road from Broad Street to a point 160 feet south of Powell Avenue.
- (e) Stanwood Road from Broad St. to Fair Avenue.
- (f) Hartley Road from Broad St. to Fair Avenue.
- (g) Broad Street from Remington Road to Gould Road.
