AN ORDINANCE NO. 540.

To amond Sestion 5-c of Ordinance No. 456, providing for the zoning or districting of the Village of Bexley.

BE IT CRDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF CHIO: Section 1. That Section 5 of Ordinance No. 456, providing for the zening or districting of the Village of Bexley, and the regulation, restriction of the houses, height, bulk and location of buildings and other structures and promises in said Village, passed October 23rd, 1923, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

In Class 1 districts no buildings or other structures or any part thereof shall be erected nearer to the street line (meaning thereby the boundary line between the let and the area dedicated for highway purposes along the front of the let) than 30 feet; provided, however, that if on any streetadwelling houses have been erected on at least 25% of the lets situated between two adjacent streets, then the average distance back from the street line of the houses already built in such square shall be the said back line for such square instead of the 30 feet herein established. Provided, however, no buildings or other structures or any part thereof shall be erected mearer than 40 feet to the street line on Ardmore Read or Cassingham Read between the first alley south of Broad Street and a point 174 feet south of Powell Avenue, or nearer than 50 feet to the street line thereof from said point 174 feet south of Powell Avenue, to Fair Avenue.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take offers and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
