RESOLUTION NO. 442.

By Mr. F. H. Bennet.

Declaring it necessary to construct sanitary sewers in part of Sanitary Sewer District No. 4.

That it is necessary to construct a certain part hereinafter described of the sanitary sewers provided for in a general plan for a system of sewerage for said village, which general plan was adopted by Council on the 11th day of June, 1918, and is new on file in the office of the Clerk of said village; that the pertions of the work provided for in said general plan, which it is hereby determined to construct, are as follows, to-wit: The sanitary sewers shown upon the plan of said Sower District No. 4, as follows:

(a) An eight (8) inch sewer in Charles Street from the present true sewer in the first alley west of Euclairo Avenue to the first alley west of Roche Avenue.

(b) An eight (8) inch sewer in the first alley west of Reche Avenue from Charles Street to a point 65 feet south of the south property line of the first alley south of Main Street.

(c) An eight (8) inch sewer in the first alley west of Roche Avenue.

(d) An eight (8) inch sewer in the first alley north of Livingsten Avenue from a point 40 feet west of the west line of Hoche Avenue; thence westerly to the center line of the first alley west of Roche Avenue; thence northerly in said first alley west of Roche Avenue to Charles Street.

The boundaries of that part of said District No. 4 so to be improved are described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the intersection of Roche Avenue and Livingsten avenue, said point being the south east corner of said Sanitary Sewer District No. 4; thence westerly with the south line of said District 311 feet to a point; thence northerly and parallel with the east line of said District and 311 feet therefrom to a peint, said peint being 50 feet south of the south preperty line of Charles Street; thence westerly and parallel with the south line of Charles Street and 50 feet distant therefrom to a point in the east line of Bexley Plaza Extension Addition; thence northerly with the east line of said addition to the center line of Charles Street; thence westerly with the center line of Charles Street te the east preperty line of Euclaire Avenue; thencemertherly with the east line of Euclaire Avenue to the center line of Harenwood Drive; thence easterly with the center line thereof to the center line of Cassingham Road; thence northerly with the center line of said Cassingham Read to the intersection of said center line with the south line produced of Lot Ramber One Hundred Eleven (111) of Bexley Plaza Addition; thence easterly with the south line of Lets Numbers One Hundred Eleven (111) and One Hundred Twelve (112) of said Addition to the center line of Mentrese Avenue; thence southerly with the center line of Montrese Avenue to the

center line of Mound Street; thence easterly with the center line of Mound Street to the center line of Roche Avenue; thence southerly with the center line of Reche Avenue to the place of beginning.

Be it further reselved that said sewers, tegether with the necessary heuse connections for each lot fronting and abutting upon said improvement shall be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Clerk of said village, and shall be of vitrified pipe.

Be it further resolved that the whole cost of said improvement, less ane fiftieth (1/50) thereof, shall be assessed in propertion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon all the lets and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, being the lets and lands hereinabove designated, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement; and the cost of said improvement shall include the expense of preliminiary and other surveys, the printing and publishing of notices, resolutions and ordinances required, the serving of such netices, the cost of construction, together with interest on bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of deferred assessments and all other necessary expenditures. Be it further resolved that the clerk beg and is hereby, authorized to cause this resolution to be published in the manner previded by law.
