REJOLUTION No. 443.

WHEREAS: the contract of the Village of Bealey with the City of Columbus, Ohio, providing for fire protection to Said Village expired on the 1st. day of January, 1925, and

WHEREAS, the committee heretofers appointed for the purpose of negotiating a new contract with said City of Columbus for fire protection has reported to this council that said City of Columbus has indicated its willingness to enter a contract with the village for a period of four years, reginning January 1st, 1925, and terminating January 1st, 1929, upon the following terms, to-wit: That the Division of Fire, Department of rublic Safety of Columbus shall answer fire calls from the Village of Bexley and its inhabitants and send fire apparatus and firemen to said village in like manner as fire calls are answered and fires extinguished in the City of Columbus, for which protection the Village of Berley shall pay to the City of Columbus annually a sum equal to One Dollar (\$1.00) on every One Thousand Dollars (\$\pi_1.000.00) worth of improved property within said village as listed and assessed for taxation, said assessed valuation to be determined as follows: To the assessed valuation of all buildings in said village, as shown by the Grand Duplicate of Franklin County on January 1st of each year covered by such agreement, shall be added such sum as will equal that prepertion of the entire assessed valuation of the lets and lands in the Village as the number of dwelling houses, buisiness buildings, school and university buildings and dermitories, and filling stations, bears to the number of said lots, including unallotted acreage figured at four lots per acre, tem which amount shall be added the further sum of ten per cent (10%) of the remaining assessed valuation of said lots and lands, and

WHITEAS, it is for the best interests of the Village of Bexley that a contract shall be entered into with said City of Columbus including said terms,

THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEXLEY, STATE OF CHIO:

That the Mayer and Clerk of said village be, and hereby are, authorized and directed in the name of the Village to enter into an agreement with the City of, Columbus, Onio, for fire protection for said period of four years, beginning January 1st, 1925, upon the terms and conditions hereinabove set forth and the proper officials are hereby authorized and directed to issue the vouchers of said village for the amounts becoming due under said contract, as the same respectively become due.

That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after

the earliest period allowed by law.
