

RESOLUTION NO. 498.✓

Appointing a board to report estimated assessment to pay the cost and expenses of certain improvements in the Village of Bexley, Ohio.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Council to assess the whole cost less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof, of the construction of sanitary sewers as follows, to-wit: Sanitary sewers in Sanitary Sewer District No. 4 as provided in Ordinance No. 591, passed April 28th, 1925, also as provided in Ordinance No. 581, passed March 27th, 1925; also in Sanitary Sewer District No. 3 as provided in Ordinance No. ~~627~~, passed August 11, 1925; also in Sanitary Sewer District No. 5, as provided in Ordinance No. 623, passed July 28th, 1925, and also in Sanitary Sewer District No. 6, as provided in Ordinance No. -----, passed -----, 1925; also for the construction of a relief and intercepting sanitary sewer for the sewerage of part of Sanitary Sewer Districts Nos. 1 and 4 as provided in Ordinance No. 614, passed June 9th, 1925; also for the construction of water mains as follows, to-wit: In Bratenahl Road from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue, as provided in Ordinance No. 595, passed April 28th, 1925; In Chelsea Avenue from Livingston Avenue to Mound Street, as provided by Ordinance No. 590, passed April 28th, 1925; in Stanwood Road from Broad Street to Maryland Avenue, as provided by Ordinance No. 592, passed April 28th, 1925; in Grandon Avenue from Main Street to Livingston Avenue, as provided by Ordinance No. 593, passed April 28th, 1925, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined to assess the whole cost, less ~~five~~ fifteen per cent (15%) thereof, for the construction of water mains between Caroline Avenue and Delmar Drive in Drexel Avenue, Walnut Street, Dawson Avenue, Cassady Avenue and Delmar Drive, as provided in Ordinance No. 607, passed May 26th, 1925; all in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvements, and

WHEREAS, it has also been determined by Council to assess the whole cost, less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof, and the cost of intersections, of the improvement of the following described streets in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvements, to-wit: Roche Avenue from Astor Avenue to Livingston Avenue, as provided by Ordinance No. 574, passed March 27th, 1925; Vernon Road from Astor Avenue to Livingston Avenue, as provided by Ordinance No. 580, passed March 27th, 1925; Brentwood Road from Drexel Avenue to Belgard Lane, as provided by Ordinance No. 577, passed March 27th, 1925; Remington Road from Broad Street to a point 174 feet south of Powell Avenue, as provided by

Ordinance No. 576, passed March 27th, 1925; Montrose Avenue from Main Street to Charles Street, as provided by Ordinance No. 579, passed March 27th, 1925; Meadow Park Avenue between Broad Street and a three (3) acre tract marked Reserve in Cheek Brothers Addition, as provided by Ordinance No. 578, passed March 27th, 1925; and Cassingham Road between Main Street and Charles Street, as provided by Ordinance No. 575, passed March 27th, 1925,

NOW, THEREFORE:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BEAVER, STATE OF OHIO:

That C. E. Underwood and Herman Engler and C. E. Lynas, three disinterested free holders of the Village be, and they are hereby appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in the ordinances hereinabove mentioned providing for said improvements in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from the improvements to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and to report to this Council the said estimated assessment.
